It has been since March.




Now Victoria is in a State of Disaster.



It helps the government to do more. There will be more information about this later in the week.








1. Some places stay open


- beer and wine shops.

- banks




- places that sell baby things.

The army are helping the police too.




You need a signed paper to go to work.

Your boss also signs the paper.




Your boss gives you the paper.




