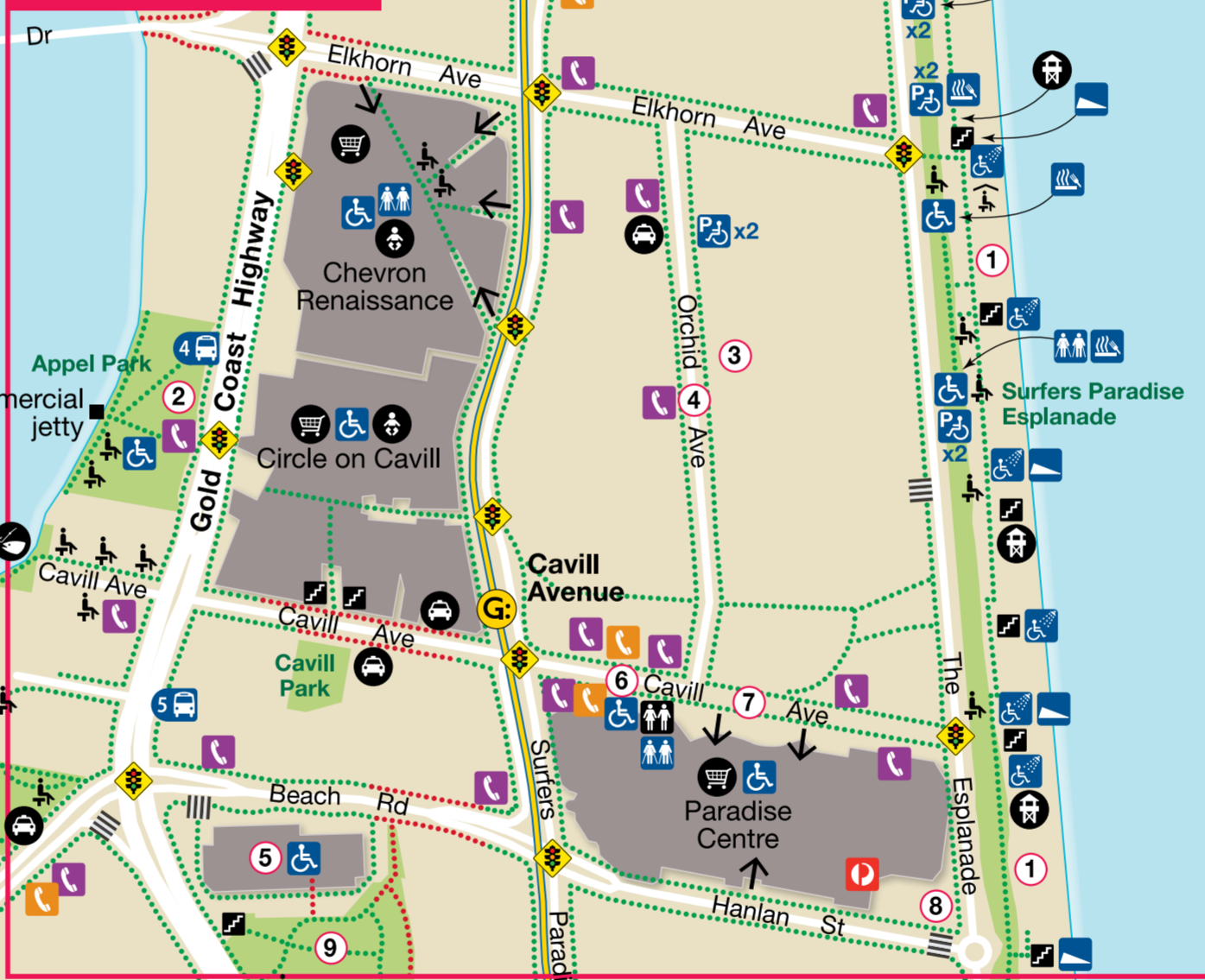

1 Surfers Paradise Foreshore and Beach

Surfers Paradise Foreshore connects the heart of Surfers Paradise to the beach and creates an accessible public space with infrastructure for recreational activities and events. There are several beach access points and public amenities along the Foreshore.



5 Surfers Paradise Transit Centre (bus station)

Includes a coach station for long distance coaches with services to Brisbane, Byron Bay and beyond (no local bus services). The booking hall of the Transit Centre has been redeveloped into 'The 4217' food and retail centre. Level access to the building is from the bus depot at the rear of building.

The adjoining Bruce Bishop Carpark offers car parking spaces on seven levels, with 12 designated accessible car parking spaces available. The carpark has 24 hour closed circuit television surveillance (CCTV) and security patrols.

7 Cavill Avenue Mall

Located in the heart of the Surfers Paradise shopping and entertainment precinct, the pedestrian mall features dining, entertainment and retail outlets and provides access from Cavill Avenue G:link station to the Surfers Paradise Foreshore and beach.



G:link stations

There are two G:link light rail stations in central Surfers Paradise. Surfers Paradise Station gives you the most direct access to Q1 Tower and Skypoint Observation Deck. Cavill Avenue Station is located adjacent to Circle on Cavill and is the most direct access to Orchard Avenue, Cavill Mall and the Appel Park Wharf section of the Surfers Central Riverwalk along the Nerang River.



4 Orchard Avenue

Located in the heart of the Surfers Paradise shopping and entertainment precinct, Orchard Avenue includes a number of dining and accommodation options and is the city's main destination for nightlife.
